THINKRF CORPORATION will be receiving financial assistance in the form of a \$287,500 contribution.

"Our Government continues to support the drivers of growth and job creation – innovation, investment, education, skills and communities," said Minister O'Connor. The Government of Canada will be investing in all six companies an amount of over to \$3.5 million.

The companies are expected to create 123 high-value, full-time jobs in the Ottawa area with an additional 202 jobs by 2017.
